

Global Learning Syllabus Design Checklist

□ Course Description

Text articulating the global/international/intercultural aspects of course subject matter

□ GL Boilerplate

Boilerplate text noting that this is an FIU Global Learning course, e.g. "This is a Global Learning Foundations course that counts towards your FIU Global Learning graduation requirement" or "This is a Discipline-specific Global Learning course that counts toward your FIU Global Learning graduation requirement."

□ GL Course Outcomes

Separate section labeled, "Global Learning Course Outcomes"—find outcomes in your course's assessment matrix at <u>https://goglobal.fiu.edu/resources/syllabi-assessments/</u>

□ GL Assessments

A mixture of traditional and authentic activities that give students opportunities to demonstrate the extent to which they've achieved the global learning course outcomes

□ Active, Collaborative Learning Strategies

Teaching and learning strategies that engage students' diverse perspectives and involve them in collaborative efforts to analyze and address complex problems and issues

□ GL Grading Criteria

Grading criteria for global learning activities and assessments, with weights that convey the importance of global learning to the overall course grade

□ Diverse Content & Readings

Primary and secondary sources that convey multiple perspectives on the course of study

□ GL Co-curricular Activity

Activities outside of the classroom that help extend and enrich classroom learning. Co-curricular activities are required for <u>GL Foundations courses</u> and elective for <u>Discipline-Specific GL courses</u>.
