Fundacion MIR and GCE

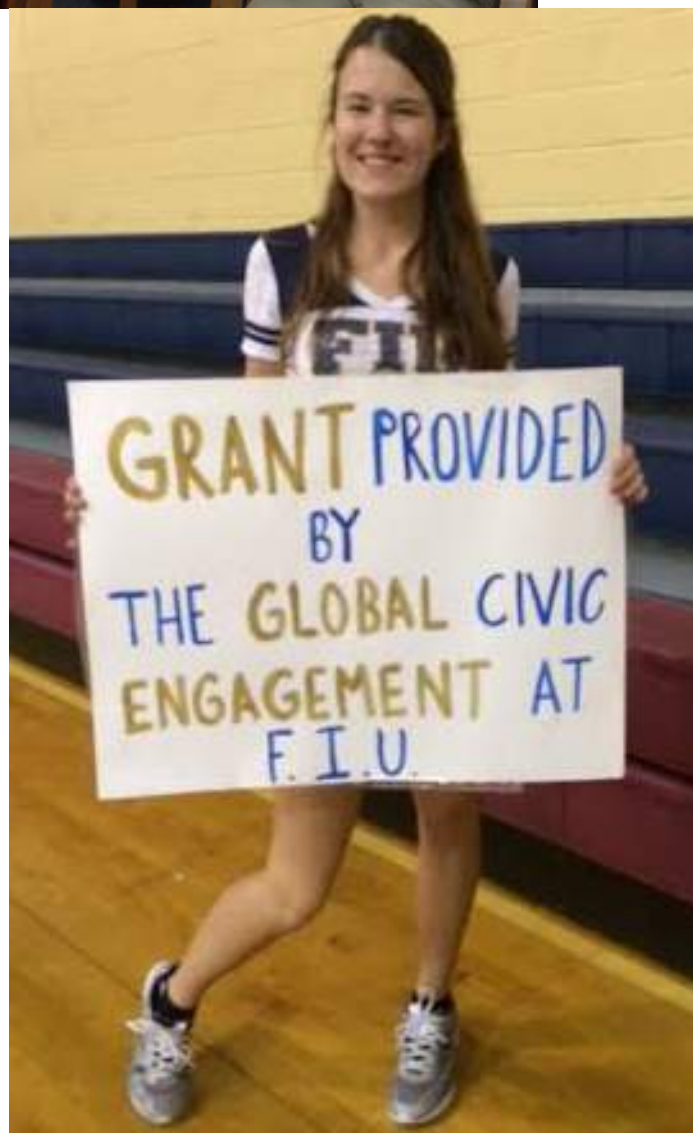
