

Student Leadership Committee

Committee Objectives:

- 1. Inspire PC Prep students work to become more engaged with the program by creating social and networking opportunities
- 2. Connect PC Prep students to available Global Engagement Project opportunities and topic ideas
- 3. Connect students to other resources or opportunities on campus that enhances their program experience
- 4. Collect program feedback from students to provide suggestions to the Office of Global Learning to improve the PC Prep experience

Structure:

- 1. Committee members serve for one-year terms beginning at the start of the Fall semester and concluding at the end of the following Spring (may change in light of graduation dates)
- 2. The Office of Global Learning emails all current PC Prep students with the opportunity to apply for a Leadership Committee position each time a position opens up.

Positions:

 The <u>Committee Chair</u> guides the vision for the group and leads by example in completing projects designed to increase awareness of, excitement about, and completion of Peace Corps Prep @ FIU. The chair is responsible for holding committee meetings, holding members accountable, and assessing the structure and performance of the committee and recommending changes to coordinator positions.

Positions (Continued):

- 2. The <u>Global Engagement Project Coordinator</u> keeps students engaged with PC Prep by creating excitement for available service project opportunities and for feeling out the interests of the PC Prep community as a whole regarding project ideas and global issues to focus on.
- 3. The <u>Peace Corps Liaison</u> ensures participation and collaboration of events hosted or initiated by Peace Corps. It is expected that they attend most of these events or at least help set them up. They are also in charge of assisting the development of presentations or orientations.
- 4. The **Resource Coordinator** identifies opportunities to collaborate with student clubs and Nonprofits on programs that will help the student explore their career and/or academic interests. They also manage resources that assist students in completing projects if needed (funding, space reservation, etc.).

Benefits for Committee Members:

- 1. Committee members will gain valuable teamwork and project management experience while leaving their mark on the Peace Corps Prep program.
- 2. Committee members will receive a letter of recommendation from the Office of Global Learning upon successful completion of their term.
- 3. Committee members will be credited up to 20 hours toward the completion of their Global Engagement Project for work done on committee projects.
